

Glass Acceptance Criteria

Sorted glass must be fed into the recycling cycle, provided it does not consist of the following types of glazing:

- Laminated glass containing components other than PVB and EVA
- Wired glass
- Glass shards contaminated with other waste
- Glass with a fire-retardant interlayer
- Borosilicate glass
- Photovoltaic glass
- Electrochromic glass
- Glass with electrical connections
- Enameled, screen-printed, or digitally printed glass
- Mechanical fasteners, metal fittings

To ensure that the shards from the removed glazing can be reused in glass production, the containers must not contain any contaminants, such as:

- Container glass
- Glass blocks
- fittings
- Glass-ceramics
- fire-resistant glass
- Ceramics, bricks, porcelain
- All types of metal (except for the spacer in insulating glass)
- Plastics
- Wood and paper
- Organic materials such as food scraps, tar...
- Scouring pads
- Lubricants
